Currency



The currency used in Bali is the Indonesian Rupiah, as Bali is one of 17,508 islands that make up the Indonesian archipelago and is the only widely accepted currency in use in Bali.

Cuisine



Balinese cuisine is a cuisine tradition of Balinese people from the volcanic island of Bali. Using a variety of spices blended with fresh vegetables, meat, and fish. Part of Indonesian cuisine demonstrates indigenous traditions and influences from other Indonesian regional cuisines, Chinese and Indian.

Language



Indonesian is the primary language spoken in Bali, Indonesia. However, do not worry if you do not speak the Indonesian language because English is also widely spoken.

Geography



Bali Island is one of the provinces in Indonesia, and this province is located between Java Island and Lombok Island. The frame area of this island is from the north that is surrounded by the Bali Sea (Laut Bali), in the east limited by Lombok Strait, in the south limited by the Indian Ocean, and in the west limited Bali Strait. Bali Province consists of Bali Island, Nusa Penida Island, Nusa Lembongan Island, Nusa Ceningan Island, and Menjangan Island, and its area thorough out is about 5.632,86 kilometers square.

Climate



Bali has a tropical climate and is hot all year round and has a relatively dry season from April to October, however, some showers can still occur.

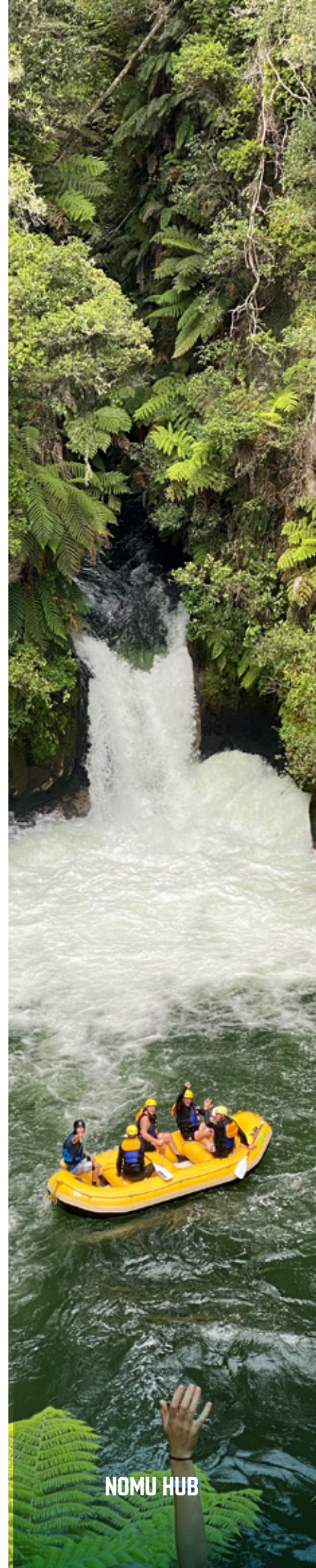

In the meantime, NomuHub will be reviewing your application.

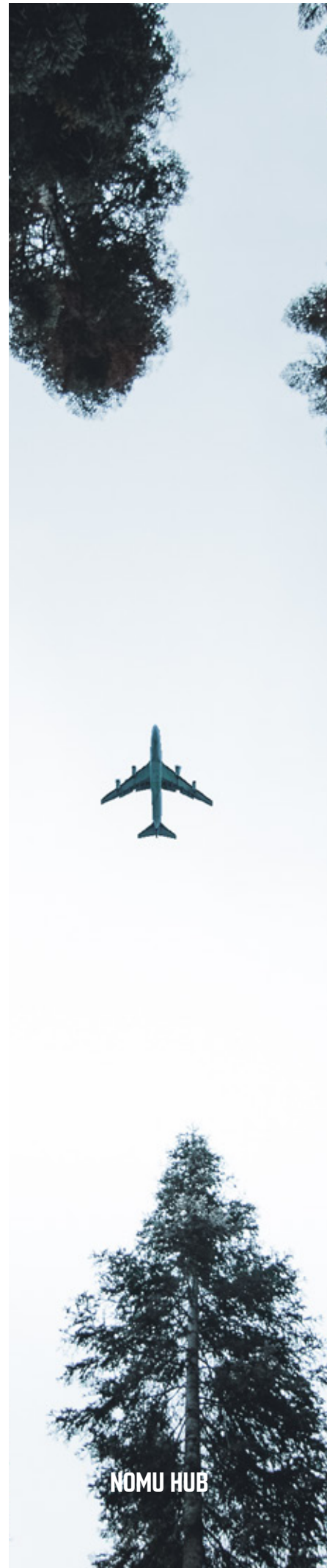
■ Step 3

Book Flights, Visa and Travel Insurance

According to the information provided to you in this manual, kindly follow the instructions to further your application process.

Make plans to visit your doctor and get any needed **vaccines**.

For GCC passport holders, the visa can be obtained upon arrival at Bali Airport.



BOOKING PROCESS

■ Step 4

Complete Full Payment

You will get an email reminder 2 weeks before the trip start date to **complete the rest of your payment**. Final payments must be completed no later than 1 week prior to your trip start date, otherwise your application will be cancelled.

■ Step 5

Receive Confirmation Email

Following full payment completion, an email and a call confirming your accommodation dates and airport transfers will be made to you.


Ready to go!

COVID-19 RELATED GUIDELINES

Quarantine

There is no quarantine requirement for travelers coming to Bali.



Arrival

CR test isn't required as long as you are fully vaccinated, please have your proof of vaccination ready upon the arrival and download and register in the Peduli Lindungi app.



Departure

Depending on the destination that you are traveling back to, you might be required to present a negative PCR test upon your arrival. NomuHub will facilitate to all volunteers the logistics to conduct the test.

COVID -19 Travel insurance

You are highly advised to obtain a COVID-19 Travel Insurance, it is your responsibility to obtain one. If you are traveling with Fly Emirates/Fly Dubai or OmanAir and have booked your tickets through their website, you will automatically have the insurance as part of the ticket coverage. Please check the availability period upon booking.



FLIGHT BOOKINGS



It is **your responsibility** to arrange for your flights, visa and travel insurance and upload all the necessary documents for us before the deadline. Further instructions regarding this are provided in the Welcoming Email you will receive.

You are required to book your flights and upload your flight details into our Google Form link (mentioned in your Welcoming Email) no later than 2 weeks prior to the trip start date, so that your airport transfers can be arranged efficiently.
