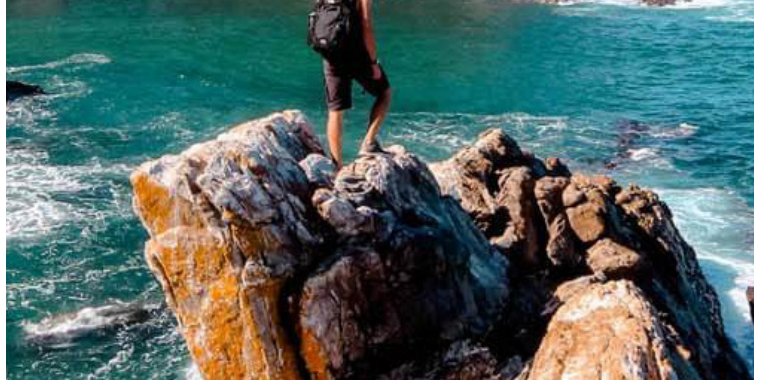

# ABOUT SOUTH AFRICA

## Currency



The official currency of South Africa is the South African Rand (ZAR), symbolized as R. It is the widely accepted currency used throughout the country. Credit cards are commonly accepted in most establishments, and ATMs are widely available for currency exchange.

## Cuisine



South African cuisine is a rich fusion of indigenous flavors mixed with Dutch, Indian, and Malay influences. Signature dishes include Braai (South African BBQ), Bobotie (spiced minced meat with egg topping), Biltong (cured dried meat), and Bunny Chow (hollowed-out bread filled with curry). The country is also famous for its world-class wines from the Cape Winelands.

## Language



South Africa has 11 official languages, with English widely spoken in urban areas, making communication easy for travelers. Other major languages include Zulu, Xhosa, and Afrikaans, reflecting the country's diverse cultural heritage.

## Geography

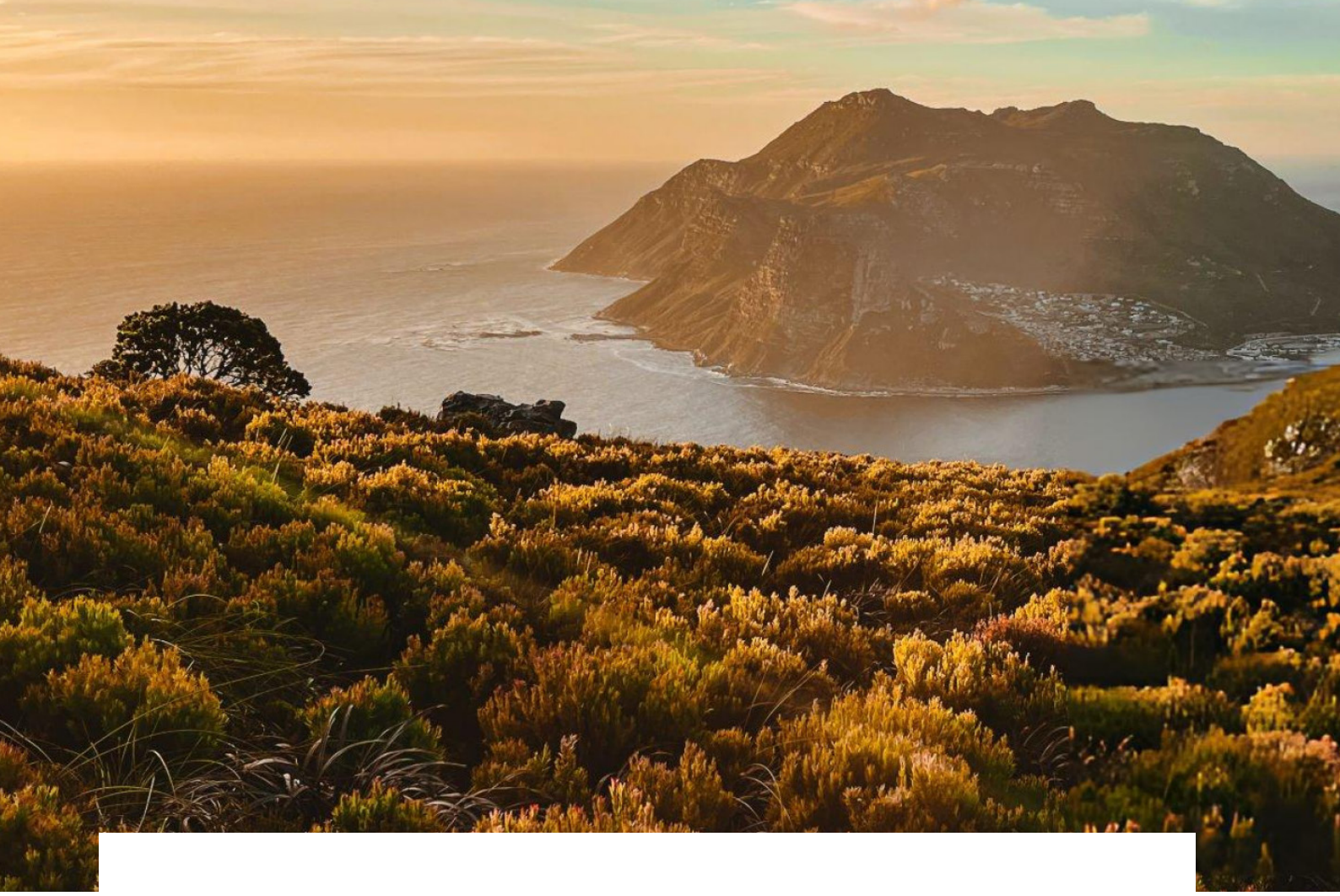


South Africa is located at the southern most tip of Africa, bordered by Namibia, Botswana, Zimbabwe, Mozambique, and Eswatini, with Lesotho as an enclave. The country boasts diverse landscapes, including Table Mountain in Cape Town, the vast savannah of Kruger National Park, the Drakensberg Mountains, and stunning coastlines along the Indian and Atlantic Oceans.

## Climate



South Africa experiences a varied climate, ranging from Mediterranean in the Cape, subtropical along the east coast, to desert in the northwest. The country enjoys warm summers (November to March) and mild winters (June to August), making it a year round destination for wildlife safaris, coastal escapes, and adventure activities.

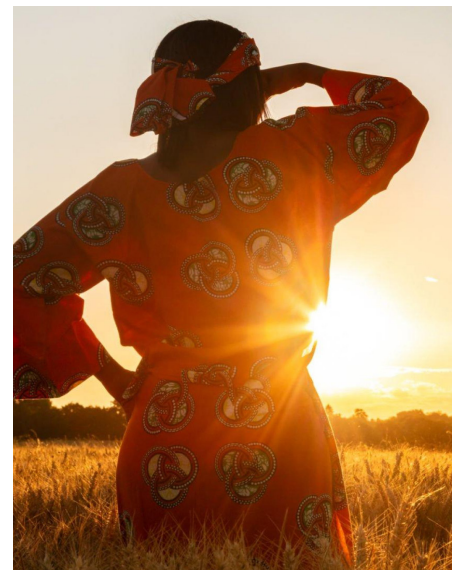

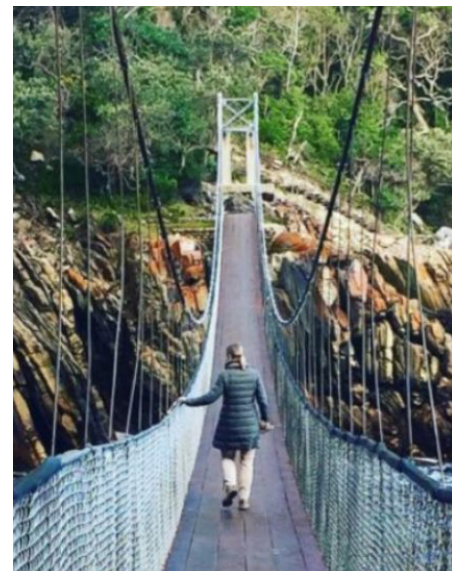
